### Financial Support

We provide small emergency grants to patients referred by a social worker. Patient needs often include:

- Medication • Housing
- Child-Care • Utilities
- Insurance • Relocation costs
- Transportation

Costs associated with transplantation can threaten even those of moderate means.

### Mentoring Program

Our mentoring program pairs transplant recipients with new transplant candidates. Our mentors are available to answer questions and provide support on an individual basis.

## WHO WE ARE

Our organization consists primarily of lung transplant recipients or candidates at the M Health Fairview University of Minnesota Medical Center and their family members.

Our underlying diseases are many, but we are united by a diagnosis of end-stage organ failure requiring a life-saving transplant.

## HOW WE STARTED

Hope Chest News began as a group that aimed to educate transplant patients through a quarterly newsletter. We soon recognized that patients' needs went beyond information. In December 2003, we formally registered as a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization and expanded our mission to include emergency grants and mentoring.

To support and educate M Health Fairview University of Minnesota Medical Center patients and their families through the process of lung transplantation and to promote public awareness of the needs of these patients.
